## Free summer meals for kids under 18

Wayland-Cohocton announces its participation in the USDA Summer Food Service Program. This program is 100 percent funded by United States Department of Agriculture. No local tax money will be used. The program will be held at the Cohocton Elementary School and at the Lawrence Parks Recreation Area. Summer educational programs will be held at the Cohocton Elementary site and the summer recreation program will be running at the park.

- Free breakfast and hot lunch will be served to any child 18 years of age or younger.
- Children do not need to be participants of the free or reduced program during the school year to participate.
- No free or reduced application to fill out.
- Children do not need to give their names or ID number.
- Nothing will be sold A La Carte, children do not need to bring money.
- Children do not need to be enrolled at Cohocton Elementary or any Wayland-Cohocton program to participate.

• Meals will be served only at Cohocton Elementary cafeteria and Lawrence Parks Recreation Area.

- Dates of services: July 5 through July 30, Mondays through Fridays.
- Breakfast will be served 8:30 to 9 a.m.
- Lunch will be served 11:30 a.m. to noon at the school and at noon at the Lawrence Parks.
- Per USDA regulations, meals must be consumed on site in the cafeteria, food cannot leave the cafeteria.
